- **Make clear and accurate notes** Make sure to take legible and accurate notes since it is not uncommon to forget key details discussed during class after it has ended. Students who keep accurate notes can review them later to review key points, recall necessary detail, solidify knowledge and study up on concepts they didn't fully comprehend during the lecture.
